I would remind you that you must be contactable throughout the school day at short notice should it be necessary if you need to pick up your child as soon as you are contacted. If your child is tested, they need to wait another 48 hours to return to school and should only return if they are feeling well and do not have a temperature (without Calpol/ Nurofen etc).
