## Phased Return to School

### Restarting School

As the children begin to return to school, I hope that school will **NOT** have to close again and that remote learning will be a thing of the past!! With this in mind I would ask for your complete support. Please support us as we work together to ensure that we get the children back into school and more importantly that we keep them in school.

You can help by:

- Following the one-way system in the playground
- Dropping off and collecting your child promptly without waiting around in the playground
- Wearing a mask whenever you enter the school grounds and at the school gate
- Maintaining 2m social distance at all times and particularly in the playground.

We work very hard in school to maintain our class bubbles in the hope that transmission is limited. Again, you can help by:

- not sending your child to school if they are sick
- getting your child tested immediately if they show any signs of Covid-19
- following Public Health advice

The activities of children outside school certainly aren't within my remit. As always, I only want the children, their families, the staff and their families to remain safe at all times.

### Phased Return to School

**P1, P2 & P3** children will return to school for two weeks on Monday 8 March.

They will then revert to remote learning from Monday 22 March until Easter.

After the Easter holidays Y1, Y2 & Y3 children will return to school. Start and finish times will be the same as they were before Christmas. The times were stated on last week's note.

All children should wear their school uniform. Free school meals will be available.

### **P4, P5, P6 & P7**

Children in Y4, Y5, Y6 & Y7 will continue remote learning and I hope that they will return to school as soon as possible after the Easter holidays. Once I know anything I will let you know. Keep listening to the news, as it is usually broadcast before I am told.

Please note that there will be no school or remote learning on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March or Friday 26<sup>th</sup> March. School will be open on 17<sup>th</sup> March for P1-3.

Hopefully we will all get back to school in the near future.
